IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE CRICKET SECTION CHAIRMAN.

Following incidents reported from the 1st XI fixture versus Worcester Nomads on Saturday 11th July the Cricket Section's Disciplinary Panel met on 14th July under its terms of reference from the club.

The Panel decided to apply sanctions to two senior players; both players have received what the panel deemed to be appropriate suspensions given their unblemished records to date. .

The Panel would like to remind all players, and indeed spectators, that they must at all times act within both the Spirit of Cricket (as defined within the Preamble to the Laws of the game) and the clubs Code of Conduct for Members, which all accept upon joining. This Code is reproduced in the clubs handbook for all to see.

It is vitally important to maintain these standards for the good of the game and for the unity and reputation of the club. Fortunately this is the first time I can recall the need for the panel to meet , but members should be assured that the Disciplinary Panel will not hesitate to act in those cases where members' conduct does not live up to these standards.
