



# Guidelines on Transportation



**Parents/guardians are responsible for arranging transportation for players to and from all youth team matches and practice sessions**

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any young person from participation, and parents/guardians should contact the Club Welfare Officer if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or practice sessions

## **COLTS CRICKET TRANSPORTATION**

The Club will keep a register of coaches and youth team managers' private vehicles for the purpose of transporting young people in connection with any fixtures or practices. However, coaches and team managers should only transport young people in exceptional circumstances (and where possible follow all guidelines on transporting young people) and should not be relied upon for transportation

## **INJURED CHILD TRANSPORTATION**

If a young person has an injury requiring hospital treatment then the parent/guardian will be contacted to take their child to the hospital. If this is not practicable then an ambulance will be called to transport the young person. Under no circumstance shall another adult be allowed to transport the young person to hospital unless the parent/guardian has specifically consented to it

## **ADULT CRICKET TRANSPORTATION**

Parents/guardians are also responsible for transporting their children to adult matches. If this is not possible then the young person may be transported by another Club member (preferably one that has been CRB checked) but under no circumstance should the young person travel on their own with the Club member
